➤ **Scope**

The dry distemper has almost disappeared in india, though some pockets shall demand the same.

Oil bound distemper is still used in large quantity. But it smells and dries late. Therefore, all major companies offer acrylic distempers. They don’t smell and dry faster. They are not water resistant but for interior, they are o.k. We offer zudo acrylic distempers.

➤ **Areas of Application**

All types of cement concrete surfaces, cement asbestos sheets as well as plaster of paris surface, as is required by the artisans who make idols of ganesh, durga etc.

➤ **Surface Preparation**

The surface must be free from any oil stains and also must be free from moisture. Dry sanding may be needed.

➤ **Technical Data**

- APPEARANCE : Smooth paste showing the colour of desired shade.
- VISCOSITY ROTO THINNER : 35 ± 5 poise
AT 30°C.
- APPLICATION VISCOSITY : 60” – 80”
- THINNER TO BE USED : Clean water
- DRYING TIME : Touch dry : 15/20 minutes
Thumb impression free time : one hour
- RECOATABILITY : After one hour.

➤ **Directions for Use**

Thin the distemper with required quantity of clean water and start brushing or use roller.
